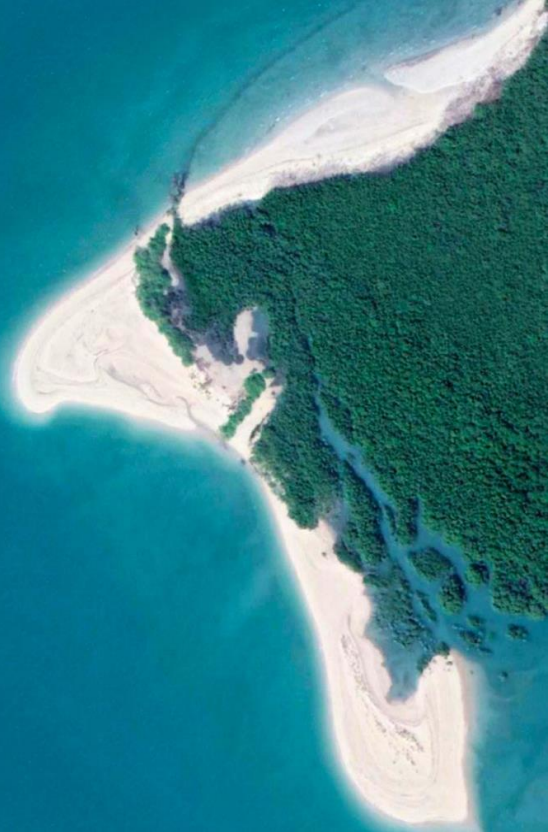


PIROTAN ISLAND

Island Profile

Pirotan island, an off shore occupying area of 99.78 Ha (approx.) is located in Khambaliya taluka of Jamnagar district. Located in the Gulf of Kutch, the island is one of the 37 islands under Marine National Park & can be reached from 3 ports/ jetties located within 6-8 NM from the island.

The island, currently accommodating no human habitation however supports unique habitats & ecosystems in its natural niche. The island, given its ecological treasures & impressive beachfront displays immense potential for transforming it into a destination worth experiencing for nature enthusiasts.

Island's landmark include the sacred shrine of Khwaja Khijer Rahmatullahialaih and a lighthouse.
